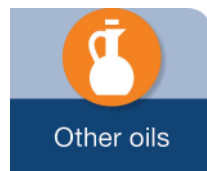
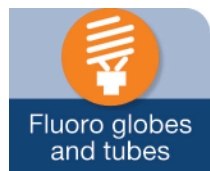
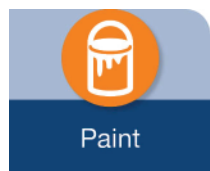


Community Recycling Centre - CRC

Inverell's Community Recycling Centre is now open at Inverell Landfill on Burtenshaw Road. Open 7 days each week, the CRC allows residents to dispose of hazardous waste for free.

The CRC accepts the following items:



NB: Only household quantities can be accepted - 20L or 20kg maximum container size.

CRC Operating Hours: Monday - Friday: 7.30am - 4.30pm | Weekends: 9.00am - 3.30pm
Closed ANZAC Day, Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day and Melbourne Cup Day.

The Community Recycling Centre is a NSW EPA Waste Less, Recycle More initiative funded from the Waste Levy.

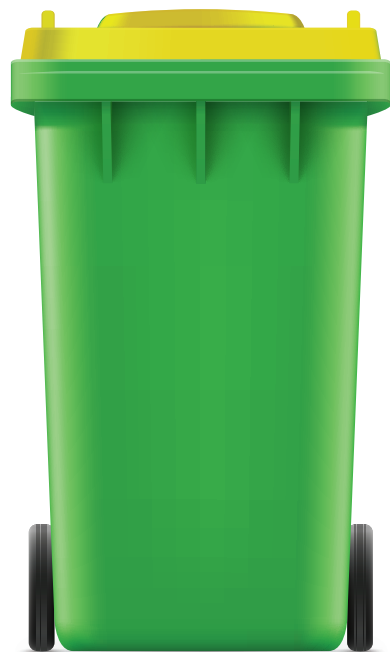

Recycling Bin - Do's and Don'ts

Please rinse items before placing in your recycling bin and do not place waste inside a plastic bag.



- Aerosol cans (empty)
- Aluminium cans
- Bottles (glass & plastic)
- Bottle tops (separate)
- Cardboard
- Glass
- Newspapers
- Paper
- Plastic containers
- Plastic bags (bundled together)
- Tin cans



Upsize your existing 240 litre yellow bin to a 360 litre recycling bin for a one-off \$30 fee. Call us on 67288200 or visit our office to apply.



- Batteries
- Fluorescent lighting
- Foam
- Gas bottles
- Oil
- Paint tins
- Polystyrene
- Print cartridges
- Scrap metal
- Tyres
- Waxed cardboard
- Wire



To ensure collection, place your bin roadside the night prior to collection and position it at least 1 metre away from other bins



Many of the above items can be disposed for free at Inverell CRC. See overleaf for more details on what residents can drop off at the CRC.

drumMUSTER

drumMUSTER is a national program helping rural landholders safely dispose of empty chemical containers.

Farmers and residents can dispose of chemical containers year round. Follow these simple steps for disposing:

- Triple rinse empty drums;
- Pour the rinse water back into spray tank;
- Remove lids and allow the container to dry;
- Take lids separately to the collection point;
- Metal containers should be punctured from top to bottom.

- Inverell Materials Recycling Facility
(adjacent to Inverell Landfill on Burtenshaw Road);
- Delungra Landfill;
- Ashford Landfill.
