LOCAL HERITAGE ASSISTANCE FUND 2016/2017

Each year Inverell Shire Council, with assistance from the Heritage Branch of the Office of Environment and Heritage, offers small grants through the Local Heritage Assistance Fund (the Fund) to assist property owners of heritage listed items identified in the Inverell Shire Council *Local Environmental Plan 2012*.

The aim of the Fund is to assist local heritage owners achieve as much positive work on heritage items in the local government area as possible.

APPLICATIONS

Applications for 2016/2017 are being called with a total of \$24,250.00 available.

There is an application form which needs to be completed which outlines all the supporting documents and images that are required. Application forms are available from Council's Administration Centre and website.



TYPICAL PROJECTS SUPPORTED BY THE FUND

Projects that are normally funded through this program include, but are not limited to:

- Reinstating damaged and/or missing features of the heritage item;
- Weatherproofing;
- Restumping;
- Brickwork repairs and re-pointing;
- Other conservation works and maintenance works projects
- Repairing fences, walls, verandahs, windows or roof plumbing on older buildings, and
- Repairing and conserving older buildings, historic remnants or grave sites.

HOW FUNDING IS ALLOCATED

Following assessment of the applications, funding will be allocated in accordance with the project scale, scope of works required, necessity, and application quality. In all cases the property owner will be required to provide at least matching finance for the project.
