

APPLICATION FOR WORKS WITHIN OR THE USE OF A PUBLIC PLACE FOR CONSTRUCTION

Council consent is required prior to any works undertaken on public land (i.e. overhanging signs, awnings, service provision) or the use of public land during construction activities (parking spaces, temporary construction fences on footpaths, etc.).

Depending on the intended works or use of the public place, it will be necessary to provide detailed plans of the works, including proposed measures to protect public safety. Certain works (e.g. kerb and gutter, service provision) may require detailed engineering survey and design.

It should be noted that public places must continue to be available for limited use by the public unless otherwise allowed by Council. Council reserves the right to revoke any consent to use a public place due to unforeseen contingencies.

No works may be undertaken or use commenced until such time that formal consent has been granted in response to this application.

Any consent granted will likely be subject to conditions, including the provision of public liability insurance and restoration of damage/deterioration to the public place. All relevant conditions are to be complied with prior to, during and after the works and/or use.
