#### **MAYOR'S MESSAGE**

In 2019, Councillors voted unanimously to introduce new water conservation measures, which came into effect in December 2019.

These are permanent water conservation measures which apply to all businesses, community facilities, schools and residences connected to the Copeton Dam water supply scheme, plus Ashford and Yetman water supplies.

Since establishing a water supply from Copeton Dam in 1982, there has never been a need to impose water restrictions at Inverell, Gilgai, Tingha, Mount Russell and Delungra.

While Inverell Shire has been fortunate to have reliable treated town water supplies, as a community, we should not become complacent.

At the November 2019 Council meeting the Drought Management Plan was adopted.

The Plan is Council's blueprint for how it will conserve treated town water supplies, what types of water restrictions will apply and when they will take effect as well as emergency responses.

#### What this means for Businesses

From December 2019, permanent water conservation measures will apply during Daylight Saving Time. A summary of these permanent measures are provided above right. If conditions worsen, more stringent water restrictions will apply.

For this purpose, Council has set out five levels of water restrictions, ranging from Level 1 (Low) where sprinklers are limited to two hours per day, to Level 5 (Emergency), where all outdoor use is banned. The table overleaf provides an overview of water restriction levels.

Council and WaterNSW will carefully monitor the water supplies going forward, including Yetman and Ashford and ensure our community is updated.

I encourage residents and business owners to keep abreast of water restriction levels and waterwise information by following Council on social media, visiting our website or through local news outlets.
